1. SCC did not hold a meeting since the previous meeting of the Transformers Committee in the Spring.
2. The next meeting of SCC18 is scheduled for March 12-13 at NEMA headquarters in Arlington, VA. NEC positions of IEEE will be discussed and determined at that time.
3. Regarding the National Electrical Code, Section 450 covers transformers, and is under the purview of Panel 9. I have a copy of the Public Inputs for the 2020 NEC that were submitted. They are in PDF format, and I can send a copy to anyone who requests same. I believe they can also be downloaded directly from the NFPA Website.
